- a) Explain three developmental stages of a block pattern. (6Marks)
 - State three points to consider during adaptation of block patterns.

 - Illustrate any pattern used during your class project giving information that can enable one to use it effectively. (6Marks)
- (a) Children's apparel must be durable. Explain how this can be achieved when designing their clothing. (3Marks)
 - (b) When designing children's clothes describe how safety, a key factor in their apparel can be ensured. (3marks)
- Describe 5 pieces of equipment used during your pattern drafting exercise.
 (5 Marks)
- Outline the different types of seam allowances that can be found on a pattern. (4Marks)

SECTION B (20 MARKS)

Answer only Two questions in this section. Each question carries 10 Marks.

- Using ¼ scale slopers demonstrate the adaptation of a basic skirt block.
- Discuss apparel styles that meet children's need for self-help.
- Describe the clothing needs for toddlers.
- Illustrate using ¼ scale slopers how to adapt a basic sleeve into a puffed sleeve.
