- Q3. a) Describe the process of taking any six (6) measurements needed for drafting a tailored jacket paper pattern. (3mks)
- b) Giving two reasons in each case, state four (4) factors to consider when choosing sewing notions for a tailored garment.
- Q4. a) Explain reasons for use of the following in tailored garments:
 - i. Underlining
 - ii. Interfacing (2mks)
