## Answer any THREE questions.

- Discuss the descriptive and prescriptive aspects of the philosophy of social sciences. (20 Marks)
- Drawing examples from TWO social sciences of your choice, discuss the extent to which you agree or disagree with the view that social sciences uncover facts and identify mechanisms. (20 Marks)
- Outline the naturalist argument of the unity of the scientific method and discuss in detail and with examples whether or not any THREE social sciences of your choice are scientific. (20 Marks)
- Discuss by referring to a social science of your choice the extent to which
  you agree or disagree with the view that there are law-like causal regularities
  that govern social phenomena. (20 Marks)
- 'Value neutrality in the social sciences is impossible'. Explain the extent to which you agree or disagree with this observation using sociology and political science. (20 Marks)
- Discuss, basing on any TWO social sciences, whether or not the social sciences unearth facts about individuals or social entities. (20 Marks)
